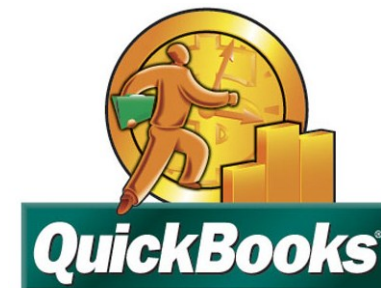
Quickbooks for Farm Financial Recordkeeping

Quickbooks is a popular financial recordkeeping program and management tool. It allows you to track and manage income, expenses, bank accounts, receivables, inventory, fixed assets, payables, loans, payroll and equity in your farm business. Quickbooks also provides you with standard and customized detailed reports that are essential to making good decisions.

During this one day hands-on computer session you will develop a simple set of farm financial records and reports while learning basic accounting skills for use with Quickbooks. Learn how the program is structured, how its files work, and how to navigate around to tailor your farm's recordkeeping needs.
